

Competitors must be 15 years of age as of December 31, 2024

ALL competitors must hold a valid FIS License before the Team Captains Meeting (TCM) scheduled before the Event.

Canadian athletes can purchase Provincial/Territorial Advanced Membership, SAIP Insurance and FIS license online under Member Services HERE.

International Athletes Notice
